Accountability	Sign in on arrival and Sign off on departure.
Site Access	Do not enter buildings or other work sites within PSFI without first seeking permission from your supervisor.
Site Amenities	Ladies and Gents toilets are located in each building. See attached map.
Clothing Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• hat for outdoors,• flat soled, covered, non-slip footwear <p>Clothing and footwear must be clean and not have been worn during aquaculture activities within the last 48 hours.</p>
Drinking Water	Do not drink from Taps. Water Coolers or bottled water are located around the site or bring your own.
Smoking/Alcohol	This is a no smoking site. Alcohol and illegal drugs are not permitted on this site.

WHS Information


Accidents & First Aid	All accidents should be reported to your supervisor or the Office Manager. They will accompany you to the nearest First Aid Officer for initial treatment.
Emergencies	If there is an emergency, such as a fire, the alarms will sound. You must evacuate the building immediately and report to the assembly area. (see attached map) The building wardens and your supervisor will assist you.
Hazards & Restrictions	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• It is your supervisor's responsibility to instruct you in the safe work practices and safety procedures of your workplace and to inform you of emergency and first aid requirements, safety signs and possible hazards. .• Do not operate any vehicles or machinery.• You should not handle any animals without close supervision.• Do not enter any restricted areas (please read all signage). <p>Sunscreen and Insect Repellent will be provided.</p>

DIRECTIONS TO Port Stephens Fisheries travelling south along Pacific Hwy

Once you have past Karuah you can take the Medowie turn off just past the truck checking station. Proceed through Medowie and follow the Nelson Bay signs. Once on the Nelson Bay Road you'll go past the winery/brewery keep going until you come to a roundabout. Turn left into Port Stephens Drive and on your right about 1 km from the roundabout there is an industrial estate and Toyota Dealership.

Slow down as at the roundabout you need to take the next road on the left just past the Toyota Dealership. The sign should indicate Taylors Beach and then after about 200 metres turn left again and you travel over a small bridge through the front gates of NSW Department of Primary Industries, Port Stephens Fisheries Institute and take the second roadway to the left. After parking your vehicle please proceed to the blue building. You have arrived !!!!

DIRECTIONS TO Port Stephens Fisheries from Sydney.

Get yourself on the freeway heading north. You will pass numerous exits for Central Coast Wyong, Gosford, Ourimbah etc etc. Just keep going straight. After you pass the Ourimbah exit you will pass a Roadhouse/Petrol Station on both the left and right. This roadhouse is approximately 60 km's before the end of the freeway. Keep going.

You will reach the end of the freeway and go into an 80 then 60km per hour Zone. You will come to a big roundabout. Turn right at the roundabout onto John Renshaw Drive following the sign for Hexham/Taree. Follow this veering right still following Taree/Hexham signs.

You will see another sign marked Taree follow this getting into your left lane. The sign is for Taree/Pacific Highway. Being in the left lane will take you over the Hexham Bridge (big bridge on the left) which crosses the Hunter River. Continue on this road (Pacific Hwy) still following signs for Taree. Do not use the Williamtown/Nelson Bay turnoff that you pass on your right (set of traffic lights) about 1 km from bridge. It is easier and better roads to head towards Raymond Terrace which is about 8 km down the road.

You will go past a Shell service station on your left and a bit further on a McDonalds on your right. Keep going.

DO NOT take the Masonite Road Raymond Terrace turn off. Instead go through the roundabout still following the signs for Taree. A few km's up the road you will see on your left a turn off for Raymond Terrace/Nelson Bay (Richardson Road). Take this exit on the left.

You will come to a roundabout, turn right following the Nelson Bay sign. Continue to follow Richardson Road which goes around Grahamstown Dam (big dam you can't miss it). After you go around the dam the road goes into bush, keep going. You will come to another roundabout. Go straight through following the Nelson Bay sign. More bush.

You will come to the end of Richardson Road at a roundabout. Turn left following the Nelson Bay signs (Nelson Bay Road). You'll go straight through another roundabout still following Nelson Bay signs. This road goes through more bush. Keep going. You will go past the Brewery/Winery on your left and go through Bobs Farm. Follow this road until you come to a roundabout. Turn left into Port Stephens Drive and on your right about 1 km from the roundabout there is a new industrial estate and Toyota dealership.

Slow down as you need to take the next road on the left just past the Toyota dealership. The sign should indicate NSW Fisheries, Taylors Beach. 200 metres after turning left turn left again and you travel over a small bridge through the front gates of Port Stephens Fisheries Institute and take the second roadway to the left.
